## AMBULANCE COVER

There will be occasions where someone at school might have to call an ambulance for your sick or injured child. An ambulance will only be called if we are unable to contact you and your child requires

urgent medical assistance. The person who is responsible for payment of this service is the patient. As a government school we do not have any medical coverage for staff or students. The cost of this service can be up to \$932 for a life threatening or urgent situation. The only way you can be covered for this ambulance service is to take out ambulance cover through one of the private health companies for around \$100 per year for a family.

Please keep your emergency contacts up to date.

#### **RE: SECONDARY SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2017 – NOW OPEN FOR APPLICATIONS**

The Department of Education coordinates a range of student scholarships, grants and prizes to meet some of the costs of secondary schooling. Nine scholarships are now open for applications through the Department's website. Scholarships in this release are available for studies in all years of secondary school, with most open to students currently completing Year 10 who intend to go on to complete the WACE. However, the two scholarships below target a broader range of applicants and aspirations, and I encourage you to consider whether students completing Year 6, 7, 8 or 9 this year at your school would be eligible:

- <u>James and Rose Coombe Scholarships</u> for regional and remote students. Several of these scholarships are available each year and successful applicants can reapply in subsequent years. The funding amount starts at \$1 000.
- <u>Maud Zervos Education Grants</u> for students with a parent/caregiver who has a disability. A 'rollover clause' in this scholarship makes funding available for each year of secondary study, subject to satisfactory attendance and progress. The funding amount starts at \$750 in lower secondary and rises to \$1 000 for upper secondary studies.

Applications close for both of these scholarships at **5.30pm on Monday**, **12 December 2016**. (Note that the closing dates vary for some of the other published scholarships)

Scholarship eligibility criteria and information on how to apply can be found on the Department's <u>scholarships</u> <u>webpage</u>. Please promote the scholarships to eligible students and their families, and direct them to the webpage.
