

### **ATTENDANCE**


A huge study carried out by the University of WA and Telethon Institute, looked at the effect of absence on NAPLAN results.

The study showed that a child who missed 20 days absence (1 day a fortnight) with authorised

absences, in between NAPLAN testing, had significantly lower results when the next test was done. Those children whose absences were unauthorised had four times lower results than the group with authorised attendance.

This shows the importance of contacting the school when your child is absent. **Please remember: Every day counts.**
