NAPLAN Tests

Free RATs

Last week free RATs were distributed to families to support our students to continue to attend school for face-to-face learning to minimise disruption to their schooling. You are encouraged to test your child at home if they are feeling unwell. You can also use these RATs if your child is a close contact to enable them to test daily and continue to attend school, as long as they receive a negative result, and remain asymptomatic.

If your child becomes symptomatic they should stay home and be tested for COVID-19. You should notify the school if your child tests positive for COVID-19. Refer to healthywa.wa.gov.au for information on close contact definition, testing and isolation requirements.


