

Introducing Super Enrolment Saturday! From 8am to midday on 26 November we'll be open to take your enrolment applications – no appointments, just come on in! (and take a tour of our College while you're here). Remember to bring the following documents - we look forward to meeting you on Super Enrolment Saturday!

- Enrolment application preferably completed prior to coming in. Download the application here: https://www.butlercollege.wa.edu.au/enrolments/enrolments-how-to-apply
- If your child has a diagnosed disability, please read important information on our website (link above) before coming in to enrol
 your child.
- Your child's original birth certificate or valid passport
- 2 current proof of residential address (gas/electricity bill, drivers licence, current lease agreement (with minimum 6 months into 2023)
- Immunisation History Statement (not 'baby books')
- Most recent School Report
- VISA documentation (if child not born in Australia or temporary visa holders)
- Court orders (if applicable)
