



WA Student Assistance Payment

Families in Western Australia with school-aged children are eligible to receive a cost-of-living payment for each child via the ServiceWA app.

The WA Student Assistance Payment helps parents and carers with the cost-of-living pressures associated with sending their children to school.

All Western Australian school students in Kindergarten to Year 12. with a valid WA student number (WASN). are eligible for this cost-of-living payment. You can obtain their WA student number through the CONNECT app.

You can claim \$250 for each secondary student and \$150 for students attending primary school or Kindergarten.
