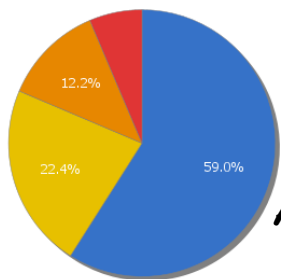

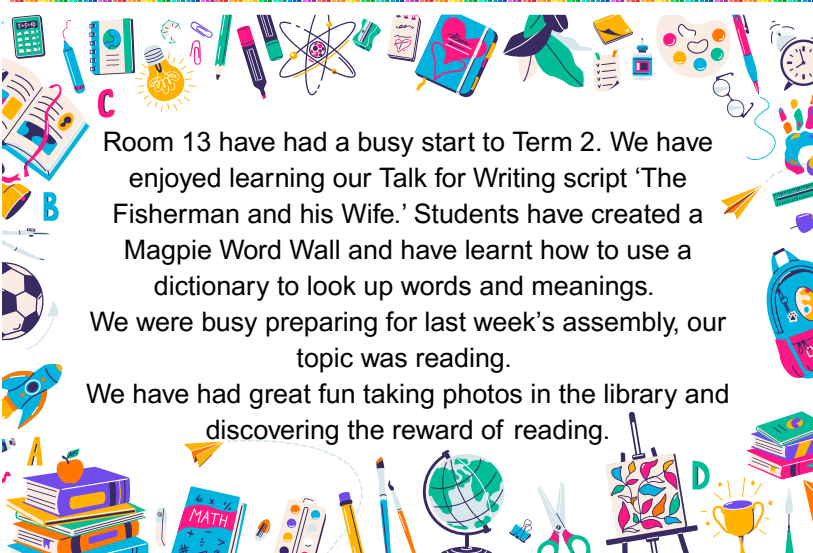
Dear parents and families,

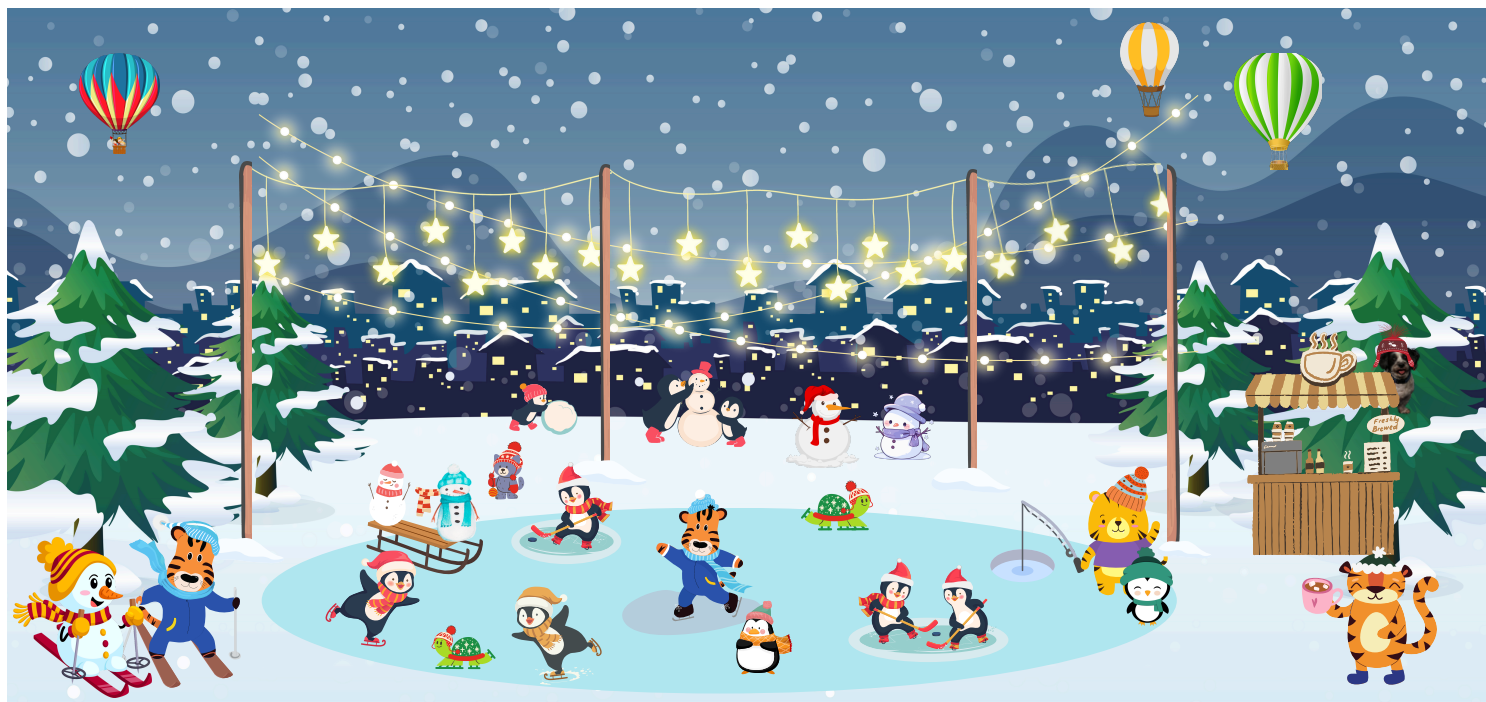
