THANK YOU MERRIWA FAMILIES...

I thank you for your ongoing support as we continue to work together to provide your children with quality teaching and learning whilst taking action to respond to the changing environment and caseload levels of COVID-19.

Reflections on our journey:

- Masks are reducing the number of close contacts when we have a case at school.
- The Year 3—6 students are amazing in wearing their masks!
- If Kindy—Year 2 students want to wear them, they are very welcome.
- We have plenty of spare masks if your child breaks or loses their own mask.
- The COVID Cleaning Team who clean all hard surfaces at least twice every day are stars!
- If you have a case at home, let us know as soon as possible so we can contact trace immediately.
- If your child is identified as being a close contact at school, once they have had a negative PCR or RAT, they can come to school. They can't go out before and after school for 7 days and must have another PCR on Day 6 or RAT on Day 7.
- The rules are changing and we will always do our best to keep you up to date.


