

Primary Extension and Challenge Program. (PEAC)

Each year all Year 4 students, throughout the state, are given the opportunity to participate in the testing program. Students are then selected, from the test results, to participate in the program during Year 5 and 6.

The test consist of two parts; Verbal Reasoning and Mathematical Reasoning. Each part takes 20 minutes.

If selected in the program you child will be offered a selection of courses, through Years 5 and 6 designed to challenge their thinking and provide the opportunity to work with other children on extension programs. The courses are held in various schools throughout the district. Parents are responsible for providing transport to and from the courses. The selection process is extremely competitive.

Our test date is Wednesday 21st October, 2020.

Parents are able to withdraw their child from the test. Please complete the withdrawal slip and return it to school if you do not wish your child to participate in the test program.
