We were so impressed with how well they spoke and their fantastic costumes.



## Attendance Draw

We will be holding the next regular attendance draw at the first briefing next term, 16 October 2020. To go into the draw your child needs to have been at school 90% of the days for third term. We will draw 10 names who get to select a regular attendance prize. Research findings from the past decade unequivocally agree that the first years of life are a critical period of intense learning for children; these years provide the foundation for later academic and social success.

Findings from both US and Australian studies highlight the importance of setting positive attendance habits early in a child's schooling. This includes attending early childhood education programs and early schooling. In an Australian study, researchers demonstrated that children who had regular attendance in the kindy and pre-primary achieved up to 20 points higher across NAPLAN domains in Year 3, compared with students who did not attend regularly.
