

What is Connect?

By now you have probably heard others in our school community talking about the introduction of the online environment called Connect.

Connect is a secure online environment developed by the Department of Education for staff, students and parents in public schools. It will give our teachers a tool to deliver content to the students via an online classroom. This means your children will be able to share with you what they are learning about. For you, Connect provides easy access to information relevant to your child's classes and their learning.

Schools can use Connect to keep you updated with important information. Things like up-coming events, excursions, classroom activities, photos and stories can be sent to you via email or, if you prefer, via a push notification on your phone.

The Connect Now app can be downloaded from the Apple App Store or Google Play.

SCHOOL SURVEY


Thank-you to all the parents/carers who competed the parent school survey, earlier this month. We had 53 surveys completed.

The information will be presented to the School Board, and is valued by the school. We will use the feedback to continue to improve the outcomes for our students.

Attendance Update: Our last fortnight attendance was 92.9%. This is approaching our target of 93%.

Research has shown that non-attendance has a variety of effects on students, both academically and socially. Absenteeism can increase social isolation, including alienation and lack of engagement with the school community and peers, leading to emotional and behavioural difficulties. Your child can win by coming to school everyday.
